> Gospel Luke 3:1-6



Today's Gospel begins with the John the Baptist's ringing call to repentance. His message is that God's ways will lead to salvation. John calls people to prepare the way for Jesus, and to let God reshape the world's social systems and people's hearts. His message was to prepare for the coming of Jesus by repenting and turning to God. However, it was not just about repentance, but about redirecting people to God and the promise of salvation.

Furthermore, John the Baptist's role was to prepare the people of Israel for Christ, by reminding them of their sin and the need to turn from it. Those who responded to his call for repentance declared it publicly through baptism.

In Advent, we can prepare the way for Jesus by opening up our hearts and being open to a Saviour who comes among us.

We know God's ways lead to salvation. God's glory will be revealed in Jesus, the judge who comes to save us. This is the good news that John proclaims, and it is good news not just for us, but for the whole world: all flesh will see God's salvation. This is God's promise and our hope. Let us prepare the way!
